Changes to the Regional Academy

The Regional Academy program will change in 2017. Below are the age requirements for the updated program going forward.

- All Netball SA Regional and Metropolitan Netball Academies will be for players 14-16 years as per the National curriculum
- To be eligible to trial for a Regional or Metropolitan Netball Academy for the 2017 intake, players must turn 14 years old by 30 September 2017
ie players must be a minimum 14 years old on 30 September 2017
- For the same intake in 2017, players cannot turn 17 years of age prior to 1st November 2017
ie they must still be 16 years old on 31 October 2017

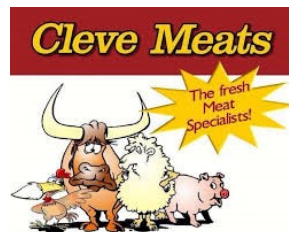
