The Eastern Ranges Football & Netball Season will again be conducted over 4 rounds which means we will play 6 home (all home games are again played at Rudall) and 6 away games with Ranges hosting the First Semi Final at Rudall on the 19th August. The Eastern Eyre Football League has a bye on the 15th July (the middle week of the school holidays).

The senior Football squad will train in Cleve every Tuesday evening all year, with the whole of Club trainings being at Rudall every Thursday night. (Note the Junior & Senior Colts will again only train once a week on Thursdays at Rudall, which will coincide with having teas available for the family afterwards).

Our senior squad has been training Tuesday and Thursday nights since early Feb with good numbers on the track which is encouraging going into the new season.

Football and netball trainings for all grades will commence on **Thursday 30th of March at Cleve**. Junior and Senior Colts starting at 5pm and Seniors at 6pm.

The Eastern Ranges Football Club is playing a Trial game against Tumby Bay at Tumby on the 8th of April starting at 12noon, more details to come.

SENIOR COLTS – Kym Villis

This will be Kym’s sixth year as senior colts coach, with the highlight being the senior colts winning their third premiership in a row last year. The senior colts numbers are very good and with the uneven numbers in some teams across the league it is quite challenging to balance game time for our lads. (Our Club will be setting up a roster to organise a car load of different lads to help out our neighbouring Clubs each week)

JUNIOR COLTS – Troy Grosser

Troy will be in charge of this group for the third year and we wish him well in guiding this talented young group through the formative years of their football. This team has been our most successful team to date.

Players Registration - Auskick

The registration process does not allow children less than 7 years of to register on SportsTG (previously known as Sporting Pulse). This prevents these boys from being named on the junior colt’s team sheet on a Saturday. While this does not create an issue for the Ranges at this stage with our present numbers, it does create a problem with insurance of these young footballers playing Auskick.

The Eastern Ranges have decided our mini minis will now play under the Auskick program. For children under 8 years of age on the 1st of January to participate in these games and trainings they must be registered with Auskick.

To register with Auskick at a cost of \$70. We suggest you use your Government Sports Voucher of \$50. It will then only cost you the additional \$20 to have your child fully covered insurance wise and reap the benefits of the Auskick Programme (including merchandise such as bags, water bottles and footballs).

For any lads that have turned 8 by 1st January and wish to play and train in the Auskick programme throughout the season will also have to register on the Sports TG webpage. For any issues on registering on Sporting Pulse please give Scratch a call on 0428 285 065. We will send out additional information once training commences.

Registration of ALL Players over 7 years of age on 1st January 2017

This year player registration of all players including juniors has changed. It is now the responsibility of individual players and officials of the Club to register themselves and their family before the start of the season. All Senior and Junior players registered last year, along with Club officials, will have received an invitation to re-register with the Eastern Ranges, along with a link to register this season. Whilst the condition is ‘unlikely’ to cause heart failure during a game, the damage could cause long term effects to his heart.

As devastating as this has been to Alex he is lucky to still be able to play sports such as golf, tennis & cricket.

Alex and his family would sincerely like to thank everyone who has sent messages, phone calls and in general for your concern. As the old saying goes ‘It takes a village to raise a child’. Kym and Kylie.

Bullfrog should be extremely proud of his achievement in his short Football career (to have play League for Norwood, State under 16 for SA selected in the all Australian team in that carnival) at the young age he is a terrific effort. To have his dreams unfortunately taken away from him is devastating. Alex has shown the strong character that he has to move on with live positively.
